INCONSISTENCY.

EDITOR REVIEW. Forbearance ceases to be a virtue, when we read in the great whiskey organ of the State, the Oregonian, without an answer such articles as are constantly appearing in its columns. It is recognized to-day by the liquor dealers all over the state as the champion of their causes and the greater foe with which prohibitionists have to contend. In a recent article which is now extensively quoted by the manufacturing industries of drunkards in this state, Mr. Scott, says: "I am to be the judge of what goes into my stomach and no other person has that right." This is true whiskey logic pure and unadulterated liberty to which Mr. Scott the Democratic and Republican party are devotedly attached, and Mr. Scott does not intend to suffer any abridgement of these, his natural rights. Of this he gives us due warning in the Oregonian of October the 3d. The fact is Mr. Scott is blinded by the conceit of his own greatness. The people of this State recognize him and his journal as the friend of the rum power and that he is constructing this power in the interest of the Republican party. Mr. Scott cares nothing for the progress of moral suasion or non-partisan action of temperance work and well he knows that it can neither destroy the liquor traffic or do harm to the old parties, but talk of a third political party, and every politician and Mr. Scott included, are up in arms. For well does he and every other-shrewd politician recognize the strength of political organization.

The Prohibition party which sprang from ten thousand votes, in 1882 to one hundred and fifty-three thousand in 1884 and which to-day is organized and is organized in every State and Territory in the union, is not a dead fossil. And we wish to assure this Mogul of the Delerium Tremens Brigade that the generation is now born which will see the liquor traffic suppressed by National Law his great devotion to personal liberty notwithstanding. But he says "The people will not suffer an abridgement of what they term their natural rights nor will they be dictated to as to what they shall eat or drink." Now, Mr. Scott, please stand up while we put to you a few plain questions. Have not the people through their Legislature as much right to prohibit you from drinking intoxicating liquors as they have to prevent me from smoking a pipe of opium? Have not the people as clear a constitutional right to prohibit you from engaging in the manufacture of intoxicating liquor as they have to prevent me from engaging in the manufacture of intoxicating liquors as they have to prevent me from engaging in the wholesale publication and distribution of obscene literature? Answer—Have the people not the same right to prevent you from opening a saloon for the manufacture of drunkards as they have to prevent me from opening a gambling house—much the least of the two evils. For you know the greatest number of gamblers both men and women gamble with due moderation and do not abuse the privilege; but because a very insignificant number of gamblers abuse this privilege you favor and have always favored its suppression by the most stringent legislative enactments. You tell me, by legislative enactments, that I shall not, under certain circumstances, eat venison, the most highly prized of all meats, and the most wholesome; neither shall I offer or have in my possession for sale or other purposes, any grouse, pheasants, ducks or mountain trout at certain seasons of the year. Now, Mr. Scott, who has been dictating to the people what they shall eat or drink? Under whose legislation were these summary laws enacted. Did you not, and do you not now, defend the summary measure in the State of New York, which prohibits the manufacture and sale of butterine, a most harmless and palatable article of diet? This vile and summary measure passed the Legislature of the Empire State by an almost unanimous vote of the Representatives of the Democratic and Republican parties, and has received your continuous endorsement as a just and wholesome law.

Now, Mr. Scott, if you have the right to say what kind of butter I shall put on my bread I must be allowed the privilege to say whether you shall drink water or whiskey. "You will soon be dictating to us what kind of clothing we shall wear." You had better, Mr. Scott, examine the statute on this subject before making yourself ridiculous again in the eyes of every lawyer in the State. Get up some morning and forget to put your pants on and start up First or Second street, and see how far you will go before you realize that the sovereign authority of Oregon has already had something to say about what kind of clothes you shall wear. You say, "we make a fundamental mistake." The fundamental mistake you make is trying to argue both sides of the question, always working in the interests of the rum traffic. Mr. Scott, the prohibition party has set itself in battle array with its head quarters in the field. You have for it a contempt, but it is mingled with fear and trembling. Yourself and liquor interests care nothing for non-partisan action, which has always meant nothing but a dress parade. We have inherited the words of Gen. Grant to Buckner: "We propose to move immediately on your works." In this contest we are here to conquer, and as Lord Wellington said at the battle of Waterloo, "It will take heavy pounding and we will see who can don't the longest."
