The following correspondence shows the possibilities of our soil. Mr. Dean of Coquille City received the analysis as given in Mr. Dyer's letter below and will publish this same matter in the Herald this week.

He gives analysis of some beets—two lots which were unfortunately of the wrong kind, one of which was raised on the mountain east of this town, and the other, the long beets, by Mr. J. B. Hunt in town on the creek bottom land.

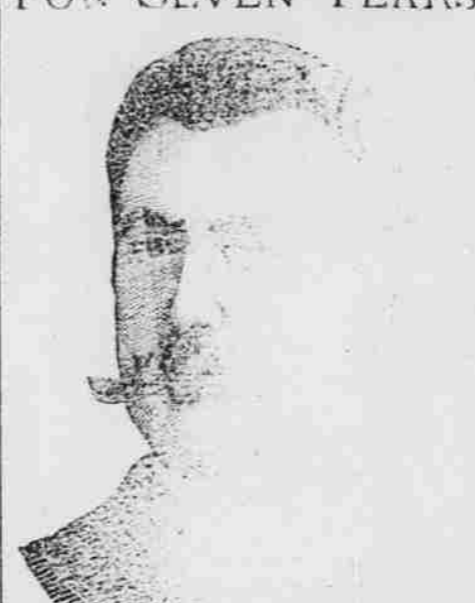
