

COMMUNICATION.

WASHINGTON, May 2nd, 1887. The beautiful Capitol of the United States is beginning to bloom now and in one week more it will be in all its glory of vernal attire.

Washington will be nothing if not lively during the month of May. The Grand Encampment of the Salvation Army opened the din on the 1st. Then Patti took up the strain with admission free to the Grand Stand ranging from ten dollars upward.

This will be the dedication of the Garfield statue by the Army of the Cumberland, with procession, music, and an oration by the late Speaker, Kuffler, by special permission of the High Custodian of political corpses, has been resuscitated for this occasion only, for a period not to exceed twenty minutes.

The work of fencing on the Drill field is going on and everything will be in readiness in due time. The enclosure is 1,050 feet in diameter, and the grand stand will be so arranged as to enable spectators to see the entire field and all of the performances.

The Garfield statue which is to be unveiled with imposing ceremonies cost \$65,000, of which \$30,000 was appropriated by Congress for the pedestal and the other \$35,000 was raised by his comrades of the Society of the Army of the Cumberland. It stands in a circle at the foot of Capitol Hill, southwesterly from the Capitol, and is a pedestrian figure of heroic size. It represents Garfield in a graceful attitude, with one hand holding a manuscript, as if he were addressing the people, and the other resting on a book supported by a column, while his top coat is thrown back, giving the figure a lifelike appearance.

An interesting statement has just been published regarding the progress of Methodism in London during the last hundred years. In 1792 there were in the London district 3 circuits, 11 ministers, 2,514 church members. In 1886 there are in the same area 93 circuits, 185 circuit ministers, 27 departmental ministers, 63 supernumeraries and 38,000 church members.

NEWSPAPERS IN 1887.

The number of papers published in the United States Territories (including Alaska) and Canada is put at 15,420; an increase of 581 in one year.

The growth of newspapers in some of the Western States would be a matter of wonder, if it were not that this year is no exception to the rule. In Kansas the increase is 89 and in Nebraska 64; while the Keystone state shows a smaller advance of 35 and the Buckeye State of 30. Pennsylvania exhibits the largest increase in dailies 17; Kansas in weeklies 81; and New York in monthlies 42. Seven states show a decrease, the most prominent instances being New Hampshire and Virginia, six each. The whole volume shows that great care has been taken to sustain its reputation as the most comprehensive work of the kind yet published, and to insure accuracy in every detail.
