WASHINGTON, May 8th, 1887. The event of the past week was the visit to Washington of the Queen of the Sandwich Islands and her suite. All sorts of obsequious attentions were paid to her majesty at the Capitol of this great Republic, for although Kopiolani has the complexion of a mulatto and the Egyptian cast of feature, she is a royal personage, and there is only one way to treat visiting royalty in this country as well as in any other. The Queen first called at the White House, and her visit was returned by Mrs. Cleveland and the ladies of the Cabinet in less than two hours, according to the royal etiquette. The conjunction of royalty and democracy was especially interesting as presented at the State dinner. The presi dent of nearly sixty unllions of freemen led out the queen consort, Kapiolani, of little more than sixty-thou-HOSIERY, TRIMMING &c. sand people, and sat at one end of his official board with the dusky hued queen on his right and the dusky princess accompanying her on his left, For once, at least, since the beginning of his Administration, Mr. Cleveland found himself flanked by two women who could not talk back to him. Neither of them had sufficient command of English for general conversation. At the other end of the table sat Mrs. Cleveland and Minister Carter, who represents the little kingdom in the Pacific ocean to this Government. Mrs. Cleveland laughed gayly as she talked to her escort and was evidently enjoying the President's situation while she was concealed from his view by large floral decoration in the cen-

ter of the table. The banquet was a most elaborate affair and in perfection of every detail was thought to excel any enterteinment given at the Executive Mansion during Mr. Cleveland's occupancy. The State apartments were profusely decorated with flowers, among which the Hawaiian colors were prominent, and the East Room surpassed the occasion of the President's wedding, not in number, perhaps, but in the selection of the flowers used.

Not speaking English she was at a disadvantage, but she was intelligent looking and apparantly quick-witted.

Probably the silliest of all the silly stories that have been told of Secretary Lamar was that one to the effect that he would not attend the State dinner given to the Queen of the Sandwich Islands on account of her color. It seems rediculous to take time to contradict so preposterous a report, were it not for the fact that some people might be just silly enough to believe it.
