Breeding Heavy Horses.

An eastern journal has a correspondent who inquires what the experience has been of those who have bred Percheron, Clydesdale and Cleveland bay horses to common mares. Oregon affords much experience of this kind; our ranges have been supplied with good sires of those breeds to mate with very common stock and even with small Indian ponies and their grades, and the result has been an improved lot of animals for their progeny, much larger than the dams and possessing many of the qualities of the sires. W. C. Myer of Jackson county, has made a thorough trial of breeding small mares to large horses with entire success, as the product is a large and heavy horse, strong even, if ungainly, that sells well for heavy teaming purposes. Such animals will sell when smaller horses of good build will not, as weight and muscle are needed. A few crosses with good sires will produce an improved mare that is capable of producing better stock that will command a good price. The Eastern ranges of Oregon and Washington are excellent for horses, as the bunch grass is strong and nutritious food that makes good bone and muscle. It is the survival of the fittest on those ranges, for the bands range over a wide country and rush over the hills at a break neck pace that kills all that are incompetent. Breeders use these horses, or good crosses from them, with entire success. —Oregonian.

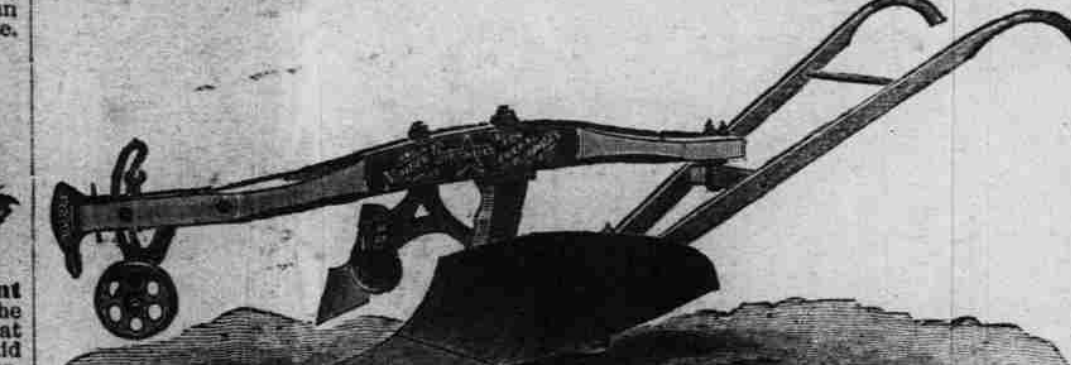
