WASHINGTON, Feb. 8.—The secretary of the treasury today made public the names of the successful bidders for the new loan, together with the amounts subscribed by each bidder. The new loan, together with the amounts subscribed by each bidder, was for \$100,000,000, with interest from February 1. The last evening of the list, completed this evening, reduces the amount awarded to J. P. Morgan and his associates by \$32,100,000, making their allotments, \$33,179,250.

WASHINGTON, Feb. 10.—The secretary of the treasury today announced that each rate has not yet been ascertained. The successful bidders are, with few exceptions, those whose names were mentioned in the press of Wednesday night as bidding above 110,687, the price offered by the Morgan syndicate. Secretary Curtis today announced to each of the 781 successful bidders a notice of acceptance of their respective bids. This notice recites the terms of the loan and announces that the department is prepared to begin the delivery of the bonds at once, and that deliveries will be continued as rapidly as the facilities of the department will permit.

WASHINGTON, Feb. 10.—A statement prepared at the treasury department, under the direction of Assistant Secretary Curtis, shows that the government will realize from the new loan \$111,783,800. The accompanying table shows the amount of bonds to be paid for each of the 150 subscribers, together with the proceeds to be paid to each. The statement also shows approximately the geographical distribution of the subscribers.
