RIOTS NOT QUELLED. Turkish Troops Still Massacring Armenians. WEYLER PRAISED. An English Correspondent Thinks He is an Able Soldier and Humane Warrior.

CONSTANTINOPLE, Aug. 30.—Rioting was renewed in the Galata quarter of this city Saturday. A sharp fusillade took place between the troops and the Armenian rioters. It lasted only a few minutes, however, and a stampedé of the revolutionists followed.

It will be remembered that several days before the raid upon the Ottoman bank threatening letters of a similar character were received by the representatives of the powers, but the foreign dignitaries stationed in Constantinople paid no attention to these warnings.

FAVORABLE TO WEYLER. An English Correspondent Speaks Well of the General. CLEVELAND, Aug. 30.—Charles Ackers, the London Times' correspondent in Cuba, has just arrived, and in an interview with the Mexican Herald, says: "General Weyler is an extremely able officer, perhaps the ablest man for the position to be found in all Spain."

BERLIN, Aug. 28.—A dispatch to the Vossische Zeitung, from Constantinople, says that there was a general fusillade and massacre. At the conclusion of the riot many hundred dead bodies were lying at the head of the Stamboul bridge.
