"Primarily the coffin is fire and burglar-proof. The case is made out of boiler iron hardened with old bone. spruce bark and leather, which forms in enamel that cannot be penetrated by chisel or drill. It is put together with angle iron and flush rivets. The locks are all on the inside, so constructed with hooks and staples with a spring behind them that when a pin is irawn out from the outside the bolts spring down and lock automatically and the coffin is then locked so that it cannot be opened from the outside. The only person who can unlock the

strange coffin is the person inside. There are two grades of coffinsthose for vaults and those to be interred in graves. The coffin to be placed in a vault is equ pedoes that can be exploded from the inside. The theory of this is that in case a person is buried alive he can throw back the bolts, explode the torpedoes and warn the sexton, and thus escape. The coffin to be placed in a grave has attached a strong spring and arm. In case the person inside finds that he wishes to get out, all he has to do is to throw back the spring, and this arm is thereby released and cuts its way to the top, exploding a torpedo and warning the keeper of the grave vard. These coffins are sold at so much per pound, and the first purchaser does not have to pay anything down. He simply gives a written guarantee to he manufacturer that he will pay for the coffin from his estate within fifteen days after death, or, failing to do this, the manufacturer can claim his body to do what he may wish with it. The offins were originally invented at Ypsilanti, Mich., and the invention was due to necessity. At the time that the company gained its inception Ypsilanti and Ann Arbor and other Michigan owns were being overrun with grave obbers. It was to counteract the effects of this that the coffins were made.
