The name of said corporation shall be The Pioneer Relief Fund Association, of Cornucopia, Oregon.

The object for which this association is formed, are, to wit: 1st. To give all possible moral and material aid in its power to its members in the cases of sickness, accidents or misfortunes.

2nd. To promote benevolence and charity by establishing a fund from which the services of good and competent medical advisers and nurses shall be secured, and also suitable rooms for the accommodation of sick members.

3rd. To develop brotherly love between its members, by encouraging each other in business, and by assisting each other to obtain work or employment.

4th. To bring comfort to the dying and take charge of the funerals of the dead members and accompany their remains to their last resting place.

5th. The diffusion of knowledge, by securing a suitable room to be used as a place of meeting for its members, and providing it with books and papers for the use of the members of the association.

The members of its directors shall be seven (7) who shall be elected annually, by ballot, on the first Monday of April of each year, and shall hold their offices until their successors are duly elected and qualified.

The names of the directors elected for the first year, are, to wit: JOSEPH LUCE, J. T. BOLLES, HUGH CURRAN, JOHN B. MORGAN, A. H. GAYLORD, GEO. O. NEWCOMB, W. R. USHER, Directors.

The place of business and office of the association shall be at Cornucopia, Union county, Oregon.

The association shall continue its corporate existence for the period of twenty-five (25) years from and after the filing of these presents in the office of the Secretary of State of Oregon.

The board of directors of this association shall meet immediately after the filing of these presents and adopt by-laws for the government of the association, and make all necessary and proper arrangements for carrying out the objects herein expressed, and as to them may seem for the best interests of the association.
