

COUNTY COURT PROCEEDINGS.

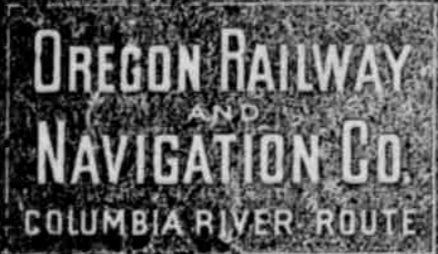
