

TREATMENT OF TREES.

Suggestions Concerning the Proper Management of Orchards.

The treatment which fruit trees should receive must accord with circumstances and with the character of the soil. Generally, young trees should be surrounded with cultivated and mellow ground, because they are more easily checked in growth than older and larger trees, which send their stronger roots deeper into the earth, and are less affected by vegetable growth on the surface.

There is no part of the management of fruit trees, and especially of young ones, where there has been a more common error than in the mistaken notion of the length of the roots. The question whether grass should be permitted to grow in an orchard must be the length of the annual shoots. Young trees, before they begin to bear, should send out their annual growth at least a foot or two in length; and after they bear, the growth should be several inches, or from six inches to a foot. If the growth is feeble, or only an inch or two when standing in grass, the trees are obviously too feeble; and if young they should receive at once broadcast culture; or if old, either this or a top-dressing of manure. Unconditional rules, however, can not be laid down while soils vary so much in different localities. The length of the annual growth must be the guide, and the treatment vary according to their pointings, and the manure or fertilizer applied which is found to be effective, often vary much with locality. As a general rule, which may be liable to exception with very rich soil, the only case in which grass may be permitted to occupy orchards, and especially of young trees, is where the grass is kept constantly mowed short with sheep, with more or less top-dressing with manure; or where the grass is cut equally short with the lawnmower, and yearly top-dressing is given. The owner will be able to judge if this treatment is admissible by the rule already given—the length of the annual shoots. In some localities, superphosphates have proved much advantage, while in others, with unlike soils, they have not paid the expense. Wood-ashes are more or less beneficial, in some instances greatly increasing the growth of the fruit as well as of the trees; but in some cases they have failed to produce any sensible effect. Nitrogenous fertilizers are often beneficial, but the peach-growers in some parts of New Jersey have found them positively detrimental. These facts all indicate the necessity for each cultivator using his own judgment and of deciding some of the questions connected with fruit-growing from his own personal observation.

—Peach Butter Pudding.—Peel ripe peaches, arrange in a baking dish and pour over the following mixture: Take a scant quart of milk, add ten tablespoonfuls of flour, six beaten eggs, a little salt and two teaspoonfuls of baking powder mixed with a little flour. Bake in a quick oven. Eat with cream and sugar.—Rural New Yorker.

—Potato Eggs.—Mash some potatoes (not too new) with a little warmed milk, or cream, butter, salt, and the yolk of an egg well beaten up. Form the mixture into egg-shaped balls by pressing it into an iron spoon (buttered); slip the potatoes out of the spoon upon buttered paper, put them into the oven to thoroughly warm, but not to become browned.

Fried Cucumbers.—Cut the cucumbers into slices, about one-sixteenth of an inch thick; season with salt and pepper; dip first in eggs and then in bread crumbs. Put two large tablespoonfuls of lard or drippings into a frying-pan; when hot, put in a few slices at a time; when brown on one side, turn and brown the other. Take out carefully; drain on piece of brown paper and serve very hot.—Table Talk.

—To the milk of bottle-fed children pure milk sugar, which can be obtained from any druggist, is the only form of sugar which should be added.

—For chapped lips mix two table-spoonfuls of clarified honey with a few drops of lavender water or any other perfume and anoint the lips frequently.

—A simple and effectual remedy for ivy poisoning is said to be sweet spirits of nitre. Bathe affected parts two or three times during the day, and the next morning scarcely any trace of the poison will remain.—Practical House-keeping.

—Lemon Syrup.—Five pints of water, six pounds of sugar, two ounces of tartaric acid. Boil these ingredients for ten minutes; add the white of an egg to clear it; boil five minutes, and, when cold, add the juice of ten lemons. Bottle and cork tightly.

—Jars may be cleansed without scraping if hot water in which one or two teaspoonfuls of pearl ash have been dissolved, be poured into them. The pearl ash will loosen the contents clinging to the bottom and sides and they will float in the water.

—To preserve grapes, take grapes and sugar, pound for pound. Remove the skins from the grapes; boil the pulps tender and strain through a sieve. Boil the skins in a little water until tender. Then boil all together until sufficiently thick.—Home and Farm.

—During the so-called teething period there is no especial predisposition to disease; but the system then is in a condition which invites, as it were, associate disorders and complications. Many of the complaints which attack teething children are merely accidental; that is, they are in no wise dependent upon dentition.
