Crop-Weather Bulletin No. 2.

The following is the report of the Oregon Weather Bureau for the week ending Saturday, March 21, 1891:

WEATHER—The temperature has risen, but is yet slightly below the normal. Showers fell during the week, but not average amount.

CROPS—Owing to the wet soil conditions in Western Oregon, melting snow and wet soil in Eastern Oregon, spring seeding has generally been delayed.

STOCK—In Willows county some stock has been lost. In other stock sections it is rare that loss is reported.

HEALTH—In some sections the "La Grippe" is prevalent, but nothing serious.
