It is money lost to feed grain that has been wet and probably through the burning of an elevator sold a little lower than the best feed. "Burned" wheat or oats not only do not furnish as much food as a sweet article, but are always a dangerous feed when fed to live stock.

The supply of green bone or ground dried meat and blood should be above suspicion. Most of the bagged meat on the market is good, but be sure that when you will run across a lot put out by an unknown firm that it is only for fertilizer. These dried meat products when exposed to dampness sometimes spoil and thus become a dangerous article to use.
