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






A REAL COWBOY WHIP. The Way to Make One That Will

Fig. 2 of the diagram shows the Proper way to braid a whip. To make the drawing simple only four strand are used, but by exactly the same netlod any number of strands from hree to fifty may be braided.

It will, however, be better to experiment with four strands until the principle of the work is understood. Take feur strands of equal length and knot them together at one end. Separate one of the strands from the rest. We will suppose that it corresponds to A in the diagram. Separate a second string from the rest and lay it across the string A. The second string will correspond to B. Lay a third string acr ss the string B. The third string corresponds to C. Lay the fourth string
