More steamers are now running between Portland and San Francisco than for years past and it is estimated that about as many passengers now go by steamer as by rail a thing that has not occurred before since pioneer day. No one seems to know any good reason for the fact. Water rates are \$8, and \$12, being about half as much as by rail.

During the past week we have had colder weather than for several years and it has been intensely cold through out the east and even in the south. The Columbia river has been so full of running ice as to greatly impede navigation and the freezing has caused the Willamette to get so low that steamers find difficulty in running even below Port and.

The federal grand jury in Portland after having been in almost constant session since early in October adjourned last Monday after having indicted many of the most prominent men in state for connection with land frauds. It is nearly three years since District Attorney John Hall and Special Agent Greene began to investigate such crookedness. About a year ago Special Prosecutor Henry was put in charge of such work out west and brought to his aid Secret Service Agent Burns who has unearthed more rascality than anybody ever dreamed of. All the rascals have not yet been caught.

Up to the end of last week 271 Senate bills had been introduced into the state senate and 372 in the house. Of the senate bills 170 had been passed by that body and the house had passed 190 of its bills. Both houses had passed on 137 of the bills and about 100 of them had been signed or filed by the governor. Out of a total of 643 bills, less than one fourth had become laws when the session was within five days of its final adjournment. It is a blessed thing for the people that the legislature contains enough level headed men to keep in subjection the tendency to make so many needless laws. Perhaps 20 days of actual work would have been sufficient to frame all the new laws really needed.

When Senator Mitchell went back to Washington and made such a bold denial of the charges against him in Oregon, congress was ready and willing to accept as true his version of the matter. But as one thing after another against him gradually leaked out they began to grow suspicious and doubtful and when the story of his private secretary came out, all hands concluded he was guilty and thousands of his former warm friends have dropped like a hot potato. He may refuse to resign and his trial may drag along to the end of his senatorial term but never again will John H. Mitchell be honored or trusted by his state or the nation.

Judge Tanner, law partner for Senator Mitchell, admitted before Judge Bellinger that he had committed perjury in testifying as to Mitchell's connection with land fraud cases his only object being to shield the senator from possible consequences. And now the whole republican camp is in an uproar and dilemma as to what should be done. Most of them agree that Mitchell's days of usefulness are over and that he should at once resign so that the present legislature might choose his successor, to guard against Governor Chamberlain appointing a democrat in case he is kicked out. But all the powers in the state have been unable to beat such an idea into his head. That vote of confidence last week seems to have been a little too previous.
