There is only one reason for a cut in wages at this time, and that is the plentifulness of men who want jobs. Two months ago it was entirely different, and as a prominent logging camp boss said to us recently, then he hardly dared look across at one of his men or he would get mad and quit, and it would take time and money to fill his place. Now there were several applicants for every job, and he could talk as rough to them as he wanted to. Labor, like everything else, is regulated by the supply and the demand.

As has been ascertained for some time the T. G. & T. Co., bank at Portland, has closed its doors. This was one of the banks to be helped out by this continued holiday business. And now these same Portland banks, for whom this nonsense and delay of court business is being made, refuse to cash checks on country banks. The whole proclamation business was an unwise idea from the start. It is not fair to protect one class of people at the expense of another, no more than to call the state's money safe in a busted bank and let the depositors whistle for whatever percentage they may be able to get out of their depositors.

He says that if he discovers the guilty one he'll sue them for damages; two thousand dollars for endangering his health by getting his feet wet.
