Uncle Bill Brown May Yet Have Oil Well.

In conversation with Uncle Bill Brown the other day we learn that indications are pointing more strongly than ever to the finding of oil on his farm near town where boring is now in progress. This was announced in the Itemizer some three weeks ago, but many were skeptical that such could be the outcome. It is not yet an assured find, but those who claim to know, say that such a find is not only possible, but very probable. After getting down with the first well some 100 feet, the casing became bent, and the drill had to be taken up and drilling began anew. This was done not many feet away from the old one. In the first well they found a vein of light green water, and have now reached another such vein in the second well. Texas oil belt, and familiar with its discoveries and workings there, says this green fluid is undoubtedly a precursor of an oil gusher. He says they always strike such a fluid at varying depths and all the farther on the real stuff, but that 100 or 200 feet may intervene. Rev. Mars is enthusiastic over this colored water being found and to his mind there is no doubt that oil will be struck.

Looks Like Oil.

Mr. Brown sent a bottle of the fluid to the agricultural college for analysis last Saturday and an opinion from the chemical expert there is most anxiously awaited.

Chamberlain to Speak.

Governor George E. Chamberlain will address the citizens of Dallas and vicinity at the Woodman hall on next Wednesday evening. Large crowds are expected to attend, and it is expected that it will be the same here. Bring out your family and hear the important issues of the campaign intelligently portrayed. The Dallas band will be in attendance to furnish music for the occasion. At one o'clock Governor Chamberlain will make a speech at Independence in the opera house and will no doubt have a large crowd out to hear him. The governor stands as the only firm and steadfast adherent of the people's principle, and will be able to fully explain to you why such should receive the support of every man not beholden to party machine work. Do not forget the date, May 27th.

That Special Meeting.

The meeting of interested property owners, called by the city council at the chambers last Friday night to confer regarding the matter of paving, was largely attended, many lady taxpayers being present. The settlement for and against paving was found by several votes taken to be about equally divided. After a long discussion, engaged in by those interested and some others, it was ordered that a committee be appointed by the council, to personally secure the expressed wish of each property owner along the route of such proposed improvement, in the matter of paving or macadamizing each block to be voted according to the number of feet owned, and to stand. If enough were found in a block to carry that block for paving, well and good, provided also that enough blocks were secured to aggregate 10,000 square yards, which it is understood the paving company must have to enter a bid for the work. The matter will be held in abeyance until the committee makes its report.
