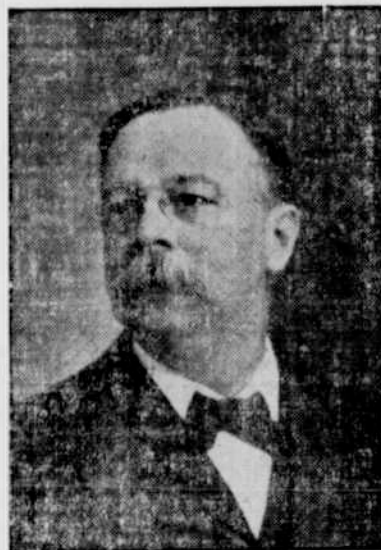

The result of the county election was not much of a surprise to anyone, as with the large majority enjoyed by the



republicans hardly any other result could be expected. Ed Dunn has been elected treasurer and John Grant as sheriff.

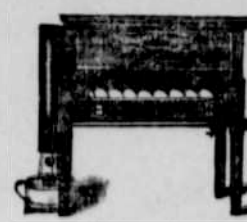
