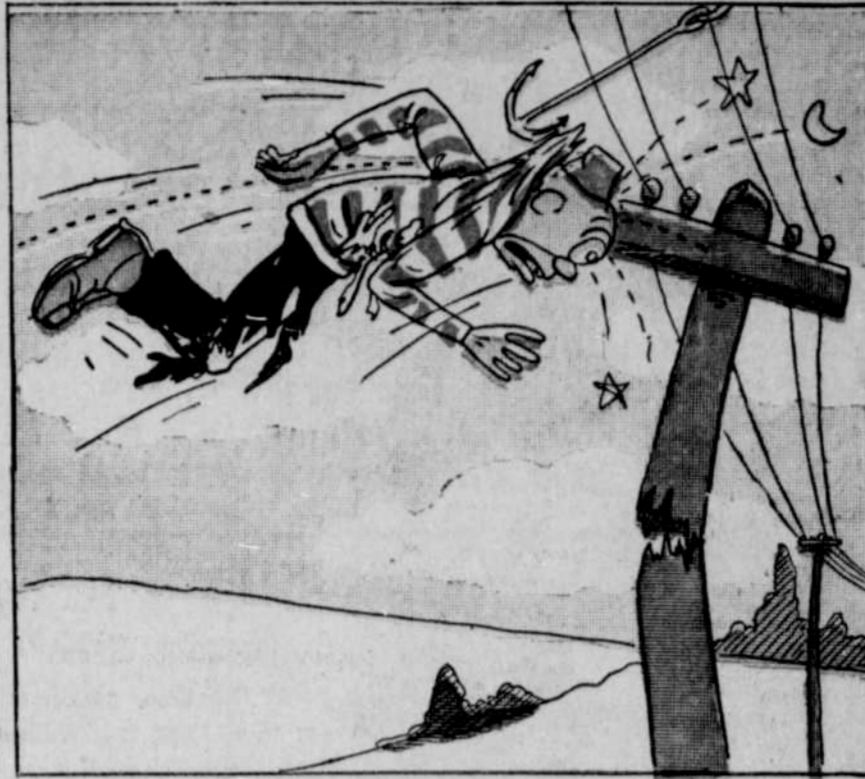

# PINKIE PRIM



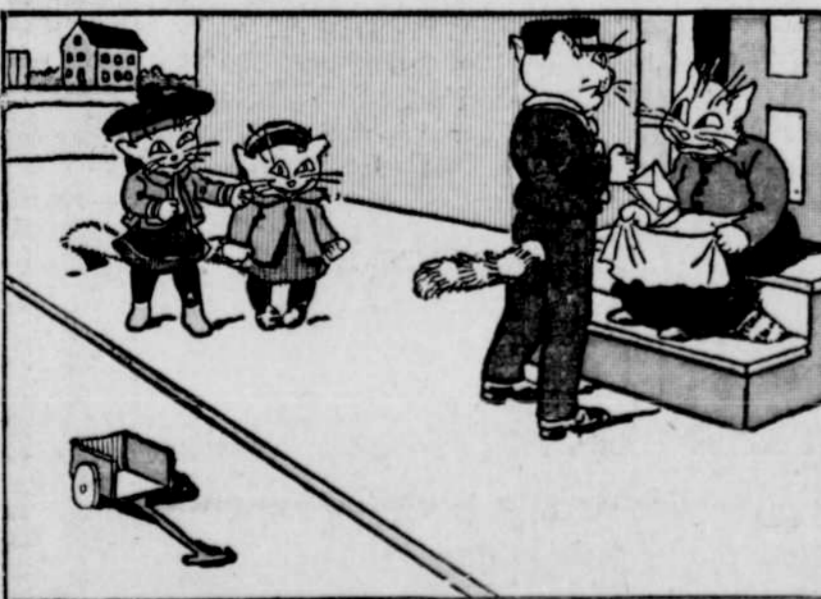
"My Mama's got a baby! I'm mighty glad it came! It's going to be a brother; And John will be its name."
