Patronize One Another for the Upbuilding of Town and County.

We notice a late dispatch in the Itemizer from Detroit, Michigan, that says the famed "Mumps" is that much nearer his place of destination. While we do not wish in any way to chide the management, yet in the interests of the whole people, many of whom are now waiting with bated breath for the arrival of the now celebrated Whatist, we must affirm that in our belief they would have best conserved their own interests and that of the people by taking a southern route, and not subjecting His Majesty to the rigors of the cold northern climes. The health of this so far sexless individual is a matter of grave concern to us all, and it is well known that it is a very easy matter for any one or thing to easily contract pneumonia on a sudden change of climate. No one would hate more to see such an occurrence than the editor of the Itemizer, and he hopes that his fears in this respect will not be realized, but there is the liability that "Mumps" will never reach our town except in a state of rigor mortis, which would approach nearly to a national disaster, after all the expense and trouble that has been gone through to get him here as an attraction for Company H's grand carnival. His splendid constitution, enormous strength, and ready adaptability to all that may betide, will, we hope, bring him through safely.

A law passed at the last election that seems to be a big mistake, and yet none of the newspapers seem to have mentioned the fact as yet, not even those directly interested. We refer to the law prohibiting fishing in the Rogue river in Southern Oregon except by hook and line. The passage of this law does, we think, put out of existence one of the largest industries of Curry county, namely the Hume salmon cannery. As we hear it, R. D. Hume established there at his own expense a hatchery for salmon breeding and opened the way to have a sufficient amount of salmon each year for a good catch. He spent big money in the establishment of a cannery, made a sort of hobby of the proper care and propagation of fish, and invented a number of improvements in the canning line, so that his finished product soon became known the world over as the best that could be obtained. They say that he put his own private mark on the salmon, so he would know his own fish when they returned. Since his death and the passage of this law, we see no way out of it but that his widow will have to cease the business, and one of the most valuable industries it has will be lost to the county. Of course if Mr. Hume had remained alive, he would have seen to it that the voters were at least made acquainted with the facts in the case, and what is a wonder to us is that the papers of the county did not take the matter up ere it was too late. The sportsmen of the counties further inland could have protected their interests in the fishing line by making the law only apply to their counties, and leaving the salmon alone, especially close to the sea. The law should really have applied only to trout in the first place.

A Pathetic Demise.

As told by our Buell correspondent Mrs. Ora Hills committed suicide by drowning herself in the waters of Mill Creek last Sunday. She was a daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Lindsay Delahunt, of Sheridan, and continued to make and solitary living combined to make her consider that life was not worth the living. Corner Chapin was notified, and he and Dr. Starbuck went out there, but considered that the building of an inquest was not necessary. She leaves a husband employed at the Sheridan Lumber Co.'s mill, and the pathetic note she left him was sufficient evidence of her intention and the cause. The note read:
"Dear George—I am going to drown myself by the little bridge toward the mill. I will never be well, so good-bye."
She was laid to rest Tuesday at the cemetery there.

Starbuck was descending the stairs at her residence on Mill street, she slipped and fell, striking her head against the newel post and sustaining a bad scalp wound, also a fractured rib. She is getting along as well as could be expected under the intelligent care of her son, Dr. A. R. Starbuck, and will soon be able to be out once more among her many friends in this city.

STATE TO USE ONE SCHOOL.

Three of Four Normals Will Remain Closed, is Belief.

There will probably be no state normal school next year except at Monmouth, the institution provided by an initiative measure at the recent election. This is the opinion of W. B. Ayer, a member of the board of regents for the state normals. The schools at Drain, Ashland and Weston will remain idle unless the legislature makes provision for their maintenance, which is regarded as unlikely by those close to the situation. The board of regents is composed of the governor, secretary of state, superintendent of public instruction; E. E. Bragg, of Union county; C. E. Spence, head of the state grange; Stephen Newell, of Grants Pass; Henry J. Maier, of The Dalles; E. Hofer, of Salem, and C. L. Starr of Salem. The Governor is chairman of the board. A meeting will probably not be held until the latter part of January, when incoming officers who will have charge of the schools may be present. "Undoubtedly the normal at Monmouth will be the only one maintained next year," said Mr. Ayer recently, "as the legislature made no appropriation for other schools. The board of regents has no power to dispose of normal school property, and I suppose the schools at Drain, Ashland and Weston will remain idle. The meeting of the board is subject to call of the chairman. I do not think it would be advisable to call a meeting until some time in January, when all the members, who will have direct supervision of the schools, will be present."

"A meeting in January would also be to advantage, as the legislature will then be in session and the board could go before that body with matters pertaining to the various institutions."

A HOT GAME.

Dallas College and Philomath Meet Friday Night.

A hot game of basketball is expected Friday night when the Philomath College five meets the Dallas College quintet for the opening game of the season. The local team has been in quiet but steady practice for several weeks and expects to be in good form for the benefit of the husky visitors from the south. Aside from its ten games in the state basketball league this season, the Dallas team will meet several other teams, including the Multnomah club and the Spartans of Portland, that lovers of sport will be amply provided for in the season just opening. Space Economizer.

What is said to be the first circular stable in Oregon has just been finished on the farm of S. E. Carnack, near Independence, by McNamara Bros., whose plans contemplate a large saving in space and labor. The barn is 60 feet in diameter, with walls 30 feet high. The foundation is of concrete, and is the ground floor. Stalls are provided for 12 horses, six cows and a carload of feeding cattle. The hayrack will hold 100 tons of hay and is equipped with a circular track and a fork. The roof is self-supporting, not a post being in the center of the structure. The stall head in the center, simplifying feeding and removal of feed. The arrangement contemplates a wide stall at the rear portion to aid in keeping the stable sanitary.
