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CEREAL PRODUCTION IN OREGON.

The census office has issued the following statistics of cereal production in Oregon for the census year ending May 31, 1890, compiled by Mr. Charles E. Kindt under the direction of Mr. John Hyde, special agent in charge of agriculture. In 1889 there were grown in Oregon 553,270 acres of wheat, which produced 9,268,224 bushels, being at the rate of 16.81 bushels per acre as against 445,077 acres and 7,480,010 bushels at the census of 1880, the yield per acre in 1879 being exactly the same as in 1889.

The total area devoted to cereals was 829,005 acres, as compared with 632,871 acres at the tenth census.
