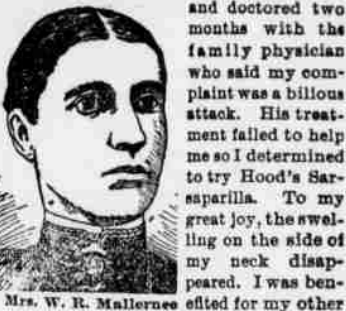

FREIGHT RATES ON WHEAT.

A Probable Reduction on the Heppner Branch. Work of the Railroad Commission.

Attorney Frank Kellogg, of this city, is in receipt of a letter bearing date of Feb. 5, 1895, from Hon. I. A. Macrum, on behalf of the board of railroad commissioners.

From the interview it was found that whilst Cold Springs station is given a grain rate on the freight schedule, there is in fact, no grain shipped from that point.

From the full investigation of the whole matter, and the prospects for a future reduction, and taking into consideration that the larger portion of the crop of 1894 has already been moved, and the possibility that the schedule for 1895 may be put into effect before all the balance of the grain is shipped out, we are

of the opinion that the best interests of the Heppner branch will be served by not further insisting upon a reduction of rates at Douglas at present.
