THE COURT'S CONCLUSIONS. Destruction of the Battle-Ship Maine Caused by the Explosion of a Submarine Mine Beneath the Battle-Ship's Bottom—Evidence on Which This Conclusion is Based.

"At frame 17 the outer shell of the ship, from a point 1 1/2 feet from the middle line of the ship and six feet above the keel when in normal position, had been forced to about four feet above the surface of the water, therefore about 34 feet above where it would have been had she sunk uninjured.

"In the opinion of the court, this effect could have been produced only by the explosion of a mine situated under the bottom of the ship at about frame 18, somewhat on the port side of the ship."
