WAR NEWS!

A Hong Kong dispatch says: Manila and then send him such troops as are necessary to control the Philippines. At least 5,000 troops will be en route in ten days.

JAMAICA, May 4.—The British consul at Santiago de Cuba is said to have been attacked by a mob and killed a Spaniard, and has been imprisoned.

WASHINGTON, May 4.—It is said that the Spanish Cape Verde squadron has returned to join that of Cadiz.

WASHINGTON, May 4.—Diapatches from Commander Dewey failed to arrive at Hong Kong. It is thought the people will not be held in suspense longer than today in reference to the big naval fight.

WASHINGTON, May 5.—The Oregon and Idaho volunteers will be sent with others to hold down the Philippine islands. An army of 10,000 will go, to be commanded by Gen. Merriam.

NEW YORK, May 5.—A Key West special says that Cienfuegos has been bombarded by the United States, the batteries silenced and mines shelled. Thousands of people fled to the interior.

NEW YORK, May 5.—Four Spanish warships are reported off Barbadoes. A battle with the Oregon is expected. It is expected that Porto Rico will be captured by Americans within 48 hours.

MADRID, May 6.—A mob of 8,000 striking miners had to be dispersed by troops at Marchena, 30 miles from Cordoba.
