Vibration of Steamers. The discomfort of excessive vibration on board the fast sailing ocean steamers has increased so much with the increase in the speed of travel that investigations have been made into the subject with a view of modifying the inconvenience caused to passen gers. An apparatus has been devised for measuring and registering the vi brations. Apart from the experience gained with warships and torpede boats, vibration has been observed in recent times on all the large fast mer chant steamers. The usual idea is that this vibration is due to the action or the powerful engines.
