CORBETT WHIPPED.
The Sailor Had the Best of It From the Start.

If prize-ring contests could be won by wind James J. Corbett would win all fights weeks before they were pulled off, and would be champion of the world, but alas, it takes blows as hard as billiard balls to win a fight, and Pomposo Jim has lost his power to deal such blows. This was demonstrated last night before the Lenox Club in New York when he met Tom Sharkey.

For days Corbett's friends had been predicting a walkover for Jim, and the betting has been 100 to 80 on the ex-champion. These odds were changed after the second round last night to 2 to 1 on Sharkey, who succeeded in this round in knocking his opponent down with a right hand swing. From that time on the battle was all going the way of the sailor lad up to the ninth round, when "Connie" McVay, one of Corbett's seconds, jumped into the ring and appealed to the referee in Corbett's behalf.

This act brought the encounter to a close with a decision in favor of Sharkey. It is not known why McVay acted so, unless it was to save Corbett from a complete knockout or to cause all bets to be declared off—which was done. The winners protested, but the losers outbattered them and the referee stood by his first decision and no bets were paid.

When Corbett discovered what McVay had done he made an effort to get at him but was prevented by the police. The crowd was estimated at 9000, and the receipts, it is said, will figure \$45,000. Corbett, as usual, claims that he had his man whipped and only needed a few more rounds, but the spectators almost to a man talk in a different way.
