WILL NEED AMERICAN WHEAT

The New York Herald's cable advices from Paris recently said: From the latest figures obtainable, Secretary Green of the American Chamber of Commerce here, has prepared an interesting report upon the grain crop of France.

In 1900 the French area under cultivation in wheat was 16,649,549 acres, an increase of 148,596 acres, or nearly one per cent. The crop came through the first part of the year in very good condition.

It is also a recognized fact that the severe winter which injured the wheat in France, had a much more destructive effect upon the cereal in Germany.

Considered apart from the London situation, the market in this country might be considered as not devoid of moderately encouraging features. The mills are unquestionably using up wool faster now than they were a few weeks ago, and they are consequently more of a factor in the raw material market.
