SNOW STOBUTS IN THE EAST

Streets Blockaded,

Through Efforts of Sepator Mitchell Senate Passes Indian War Veteran Pension Bill-Miss Stone Released.

NEW YORK, Feb. 17 .- New York City has borne the brunt of the fiercest snow storm that has struck this section of country since the great blizzard of 1888. Beginning soon after midnight the storm increased rapidly until by day break the whole city was completely snowed under. The fall up to 3 o'clock this afternoon was 9 3 10 inches.

The congestion of traffic on the Manhattan street car lines was severe during the morning, when many of the avenues were blocked with long lines of stalled cars. On Broadway the wheel traffic was confined to narrow lanes between high snow hills, and along these cabs, trucks and cars crawled at a snail's pace. The conditions of traffic were in every respect worse than in the great blizzard of 1888.
