BACTERIA IN BEETS.

The Sugar Variety Found to Be a Prey to Parasitic Enemies.

Nebraska Experts at Work on Cures Which Are Necessary to the Prosperity of the Industry in That State.

Brought in Nebraska will be robbed of most of its beet sugar when the cultivation of the sugar beet becomes general among the farmers of the central and western sections of the state.

In addition two specialists in the employ of the government are busily engaged in studying the parasitic enemies of the sugar beet and will publish a detailed report of their experiments in the spring before the season for planting begins.

At present there are three factories in the state, two of them in active operation. The Norfolk plant has a capacity of 400 tons of sugar a day.

In the valley of the Platte sugar beets excel in both quality and quantity. The yield is from 15 to 30 tons to the acre, as against 8 to 15 tons in the eastern portion of the state.

The cost of production varies with the skill and experience of the farmer. It is only in exceptional cases that the expenditure including money and labor, exceeds \$60 per acre.

Planting the beets in the spring, weeding them, topping and gathering in the beets must be done by hand. It is in the skillful utilization of the hired help that the inexperienced lose money and the expert growers advise the amateurs to begin with small patches and gradually learn the business.

Two types of disease destroy the sugar beets. The most prevalent during the last season was root decay. George H. Hedgcock, sugar beet expert in the employ of the United States department of agriculture has discovered seven forms of this disease.

Root decay sometimes leads to a better disappointment to the inexperienced grower. The leaves flourish and the plants appear healthy in every particular. But the disease has attacked the very base of the long tap root.

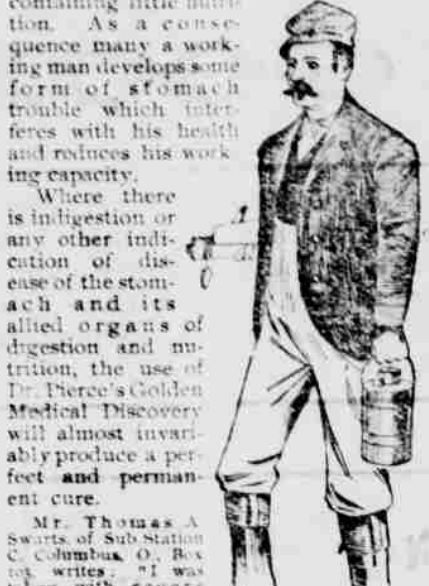
"Spotted leaf" is the other pest which annoys and discourages the beet grower. It is a mysterious chemical change in the plant which neutralizes the sugar producing qualities and makes it useless for manufacturing purposes.

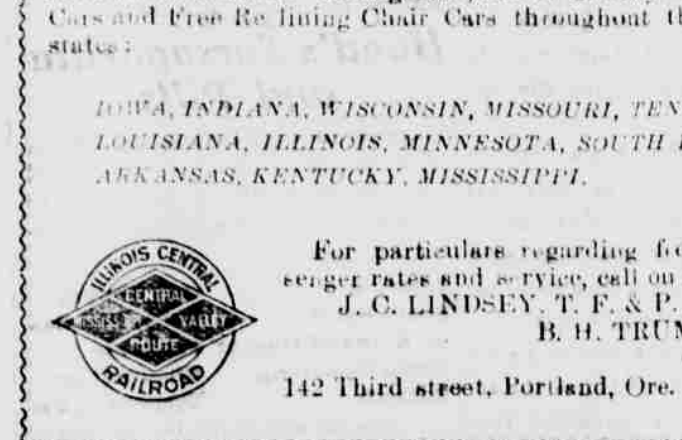
