CHAMBERLAIN IN HEPPNER.

Spoke to a Large Audience at the Opera House.

Saturday was Democratic day in Heppner, and the followers of Mr. Chamberlain and democracy were quite enthusiastic in meeting the Democratic state candidates.

Geo. E. Chamberlain accompanied by Hon. Henry Blackman, W. A. Wann and Walter M. Pierce, came in on the evening train. Considerable preparation had been made for the event. It having been arranged for the train to go back to Ione after the speaking, about 150 people came up from Ione and Lexington. The Lexington band was among the visitors.

The state candidates were met at the depot by several of the prominent Democrats, including Hon. J. W. Morrow and others. They came up Main street amid music, flying colors and the booming of cannon.

The Ione contingent wore long white badges with Chamberlain in flowing letters printed thereon. J. A. Woolery led the van, and his badge far outclassed any of the rest of the visitors, for it reached from his shoulder almost to the ground.

The bright red, furish buttons that were used to fasten the white Chamberlain badges in a great many instances were quite conspicuous.

Mr. Chamberlain was well received. The Lexington and Heppner bands played several pieces in the street before the speaking. The opera house was packed. At the opera house the exercises were opened by a beautiful solo by Miss Welch, Heppner's charming songstress.

Hon. J. W. Morrow presided over the meeting and on the stage were the state and county candidates and several prominent Democrats.

Hon. Henry Blackman was the first speaker, and being a Heppner man and so well known, was greeted with applause.

In a brief speech he outlined his position. In a short speech which was nicely delivered Hon. J. W. Morrow introduced Hon. Geo. E. Chamberlain, who was very cordially received. Mr. Chamberlain spoke for an hour and a half and was listened to attentively. It was very evident that he was out for votes, and that he is a good campaigner. There is no question. The issues were only given passing notice. He has a well filled store house of jokes, and he practically endorsed the Republican platform from top to bottom.

W. A. Wann, candidate for superintendent of public instruction closed the meeting with a short talk.

From the steps of the Palace hotel, Mr. Chamberlain spoke for a few minutes to a small audience in the street after the speaking at the opera house.

The Democrats were well pleased and the demonstration was a success.

TO THE VOTERS. Who Shall Be Morrow County's Next Sheriff?

Ever since landing in Morrow county, five years ago, I have stood ever ready and anxious to extend favors and to render assistance to my neighbors and to the people of the county generally. I have endeavored to be a good citizen at all times and to prove myself worthy of the confidence of the people.

I therefore feel at liberty to now, for the first time, ask a favor of the people—and I sincerely believe the same will be granted. The republican party to which I have belonged since infancy tendered me the nomination for sheriff of Morrow county by an almost unanimous vote of the county convention on the 15th of last March, even after I had insisted upon their giving it to another person. I wanted some man from the county to take the nomination, but the county delegates were determined to nominate me, and my name had been mentioned, all over the county, for the place three or four months prior to the convention.

Thus it will be seen that my nomination was attained by nothing but honorable, open and above-board methods, and I can see no reason why the republican party should now turn me down. I don't believe they will do it.

For the information of those with whom I am not personally acquainted I will say: That I am 32 years of age; was brought up to the hardest kind of work on my father's farm in Pennsylvania until 16 years of age, where I learned steady habits, to which I have always adhered. At the age of 16 I went to the printer's trade, and have been constantly engaged in the newspaper business ever since.

In 1889 I came to Eastern Oregon, and have spent the past 13 years in Shorman, Wasco and Morrow counties, permanently locating with my family at Heppner in 1897.

During the past five years I have paid taxes upon my newspaper plant, my business house and lot, and upon my household effects. In my past record as a business man and citizen I have nothing whatever to conceal. I have always paid my debts, and if I have ever beaten any one out of a cent, or refused to pay an obligation I do not know it. Being permanently anchored here, I would give no more uneasiness if I were placed in charge of the county finances.

The standing up fearlessly for better law and order I have made enemies, and the enemies whom I made last fall over the Pioneer's Reform are now endeavoring to defeat me, in order to prevent my becoming a peace officer of Morrow county.

Should these acts of mine be approved by the justice and peace loving people

of Morrow county, or shall they be condemned? The 2d of June will tell. It was because of these acts that my friends insisted upon my running for sheriff.

"Equal rights to all and special privileges to none" shall ever be my motto, and rich and poor shall receive equal treatment at my hands.

As to selecting a deputy in case of my election I have made no promises whatever, but the man who would serve in this capacity must be a good penman, an able, competent book-keeper, an honorable, trustworthy citizen of steady habits, and a man in whom every taxpayer would have explicit confidence.

Men of Morrow county, I most respectfully ask for your support in this campaign, and if placed at the head of Morrow county's peace authorities I shall ever be found doing my very best to serve you faithfully and well. Sincerely yours, E. M. SHUTT.
