CATCHING CRIMINALS

Operations of the National Bureau of Identification.

It was a wonderful day for the 25000 criminals of the United States and in countries when the National Bureau of Identification was conceived, says a Washington (D. C.) correspondence of the Cincinnati Enquirer.

Maj. Richard Sylvester, president of the National Association of Chiefs of Police and a member of the board of directors of the Capital City Model Prison, gave the origin of this central bureau of information for the aid of the numerous Sherlock Holmes of North America.

The walls of the bureau are lined with cabinets filled with thousands of cards each bearing upon its face the photograph of a criminal, one full of his name and the other profile. On the same side are given the measurements, age and physical characteristics of the criminal. On the back are noted such data as his name, residence, crime, etc.
