

STOCKMEN WILL ORGANIZE.

Steps Will be Taken to Prevent Outside Sheep Coming into the County.

Since a large part of Grant county is likely at any day to be tied up in a permanent forest reserve, the stockmen of this county are becoming somewhat alarmed about the future of their industry, and if the grazing privileges that it is understood is likely to be recommended, should be adopted by the interior department, many a local sheepman and cattleman of Grant county will have to practically retire from the business. It will not affect either industry more than the other, but both alike. This recommendation referred to is that no grazing privileges of any kind within the reserve will be granted to any one for a period of twelve years. This is not a rumor, but a statement actually made by a special agent of the department detailed to inspect the condition of the grass within the reserve. He stated in his opinion the permanent boundary of the proposed reserve would be on far different lines than the present boundary of the temporary reserve, but that he could not recommend any grazing privileges for the period mentioned. As stated before, this will be a serious blow to local stockmen, and outside sheepmen who have enjoyed the principal benefit from Grant county's government range in the past, are largely to blame for the present reserve condition.

An organization of resident sheep and cattlemen of Grant county is proposed, for the express object of keeping outside sheep out of the county during the coming year. It is proposed that local stockmen in all parts of the county have a definite understanding as to range, and that the same be respected. If the present sentiment continues, not an outside sheep will be allowed in the county in the future. Such stringent measures are necessary to prevent the taxable property of the county from rapidly decreasing, and thereby increasing the burden of maintaining county government.

The ranging of thousands of head of outside sheep in every part of Grant county, has been the primary cause of all range troubles that have occurred in the county, and the fact that a large number of these same outside sheepmen are advocating the Blue Mountain reserve, thereby embarrassing local stockmen, future grazing in this county by them will not be tolerated.—Blue Mountain Eagle.

UP DESCHUTES VALLEY.

Railroad Survey to Bend Has Been Completed.

The board of directors of the Columbia Southern Extension Railroad Company have approved the maps of the last section of the proposed extension from Shaniko to Bend, a distance of a trifle more than 97 miles. These maps will now go to the United States Land Office at The Dalles for filing, in order that the company may have right of way over Government land. It is notable, however, that the southernmost 27 miles of the route will cross very little Government land. Prospects of irrigation in that country, together with the promise of the railroad, has had the effect of putting most of the Government land into private hands.

Everything is now ready for the financing of this project and for construction. President Lytle expects to have all arrangements made for putting construction crews on the line early in the spring. The grades are very light and the curvature is not great. For most of the distance the line does not vary perceptibly from a dead level. From Shaniko it bears southeasterly to Trout Creek, from which point the main line climbs the divide between Hay Creek and Willow Basin, crossing Agency Plains and going through the Haystack country. The crossing of the Crooked River is a dozen miles below Prineville. From that point to Bend there is little curvature or grade in the line.

With this line completed to Bend, Central Oregon will belong to Portland's trade field. If it can be constructed to Bend next year, as it is now hoped to do, it will beat the Nevada, California & Oregon line up from Reno. If construction shall be delayed beyond next year, the line from the south may get there first and California trade will dominate half of Oregon.

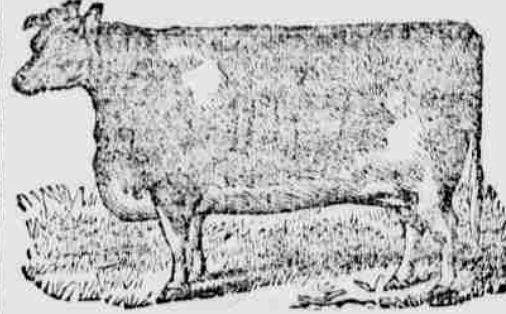
