

**Thomas B. Reed Dead.**

Washington, Dec. 6.—Thomas Brackett Reed, ex-speaker of the house of representatives, and for many years prominent in public life, died here tonight at 12:10 o'clock in his apartments in Arlington. The immediate cause of his death was uraemia.

The change for the worse was noted in Mr. Reed's condition early this morning. At 9:30 o'clock he was given a subcutaneous saline transfusion in order to stimulate his kidneys, which were failing to perform their proper functions. At 5 o'clock this afternoon the saline solution was again administered, about three quarts of the fluid being used. The heart became weaker and weaker, but the patient retained consciousness until 11 o'clock tonight, when complete coma came on.

At the bedside when he died were Mrs. Reed and Miss Katherine Reed, Doctors Gardner, McDonald, Bishop and Goodnow, and the nurses. Mr. Reed's mind was in such a state during the day that he did not recognize the seriousness of his condition. He was cheerful and conversed with those about his bedside. When it became apparent that he would not survive his illness, his wife and daughter were notified and they remained constantly at the bedside until the distinguished patient breathed his last.

With only a faint hope of saving his life, oxygen was administered throughout the day. Mr. Reed had been suffering from Bright's disease for some time, and this furnished additional cause for alarm. He passed away peacefully and without pain. No arrangements have been made for the funeral.

Mr. Reed came to Washington Monday to attend to some business before the United States Supreme Court. He was taken ill that day and went to bed. He had a slight attack of appendicitis, but later kidney trouble developed.

**President's Western Trip.**

Washington, Dec. 5.—President Roosevelt is now making the tentative arrangements for his trip to the Pacific coast next Spring. According to the present allotment of time, he will be in Oregon during May and will visit Portland after passing through the Willamette Valley from California. He plans to go West over the Southern route, going north through Oregon to the Puget Sound cities, and thence home by way of Spokane.

While the President desires to visit Alaska, he tells Senator Foster that he doubts if his time will permit of that side trip.

The fact that the President is arranging for this trip in May does away with the talk of an extra session. If such a session is found necessary it will be called later in the year.

**Tongue's Pure Food Bill.**

Washington, Dec. 5.—Representative Tongue today introduced a

pure food bill, which follows out the lines of proposed legislation suggested at the meeting of the National Food and Dairy Association, held at Portland last summer.

The bill creates, in the Department of Agriculture, a bureau to be in charge of a food commissioner. The new bureau will be required to collect samples of foods upon the market and examine them and analyze them. Persons who are guilty of placing on the market foods that are injurious to health are to be properly punished upon showings made by the bureau. Under the bill, all forms of food on the market shall be distinctly labelled and shall be sold for what they really are, in order that American products may not fall into disrepute abroad.

All food products intended for shipment to foreign countries will be held subject to inspection by the department. To facilitate business, the bureau will first establish a standard of foods of the various kinds upon which all examinations shall be based.

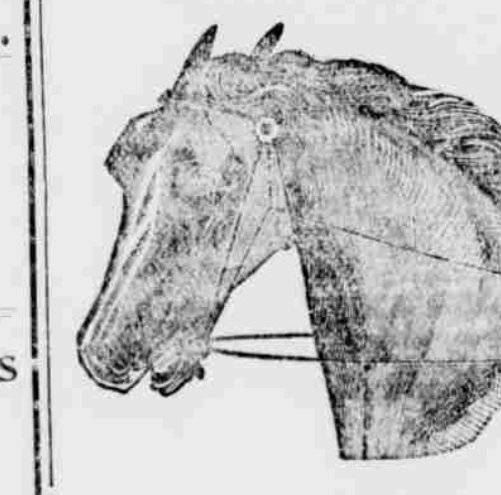
