For School Library.

County School Superintendent J. W. Shipley has mailed the following circular to the teachers of Morrow county:

HEPPER, Oregon, Dec. 15, 1902.

Dear Teacher:—In pursuance of the resolutions adopted by the annual institute of Dec. 3, 4, 5, 1902, I enclose a blank petition to you for the purpose of securing signatures of taxpayers in your district. The Library Law, if adopted, will raise \$172 for library books. The assessor, Mr. Saling, states in round numbers that the total assessed valuation of Morrow county for 1902, is \$2,500,000. It will thus be seen that to raise \$172 will only require a tax levy of .00007 per cent. Many persons will at first sight object to signing the petition, but when it is explained that a man paying taxes on \$10,000 will pay only .70 cents, and a man paying taxes on \$1,000 will pay only .07 cents, I think you will have no difficulty in securing signatures.

If possible, see all of the largest taxpayers and the representative men of your district.

It depends upon us whether this Library law is adopted or not, and I would appreciate it very much if you would begin at once with the petitions and when they are filled, send them to me at your earliest convenience, as I desire to bring the matter before the County Court about Jan. 7th, 1903. 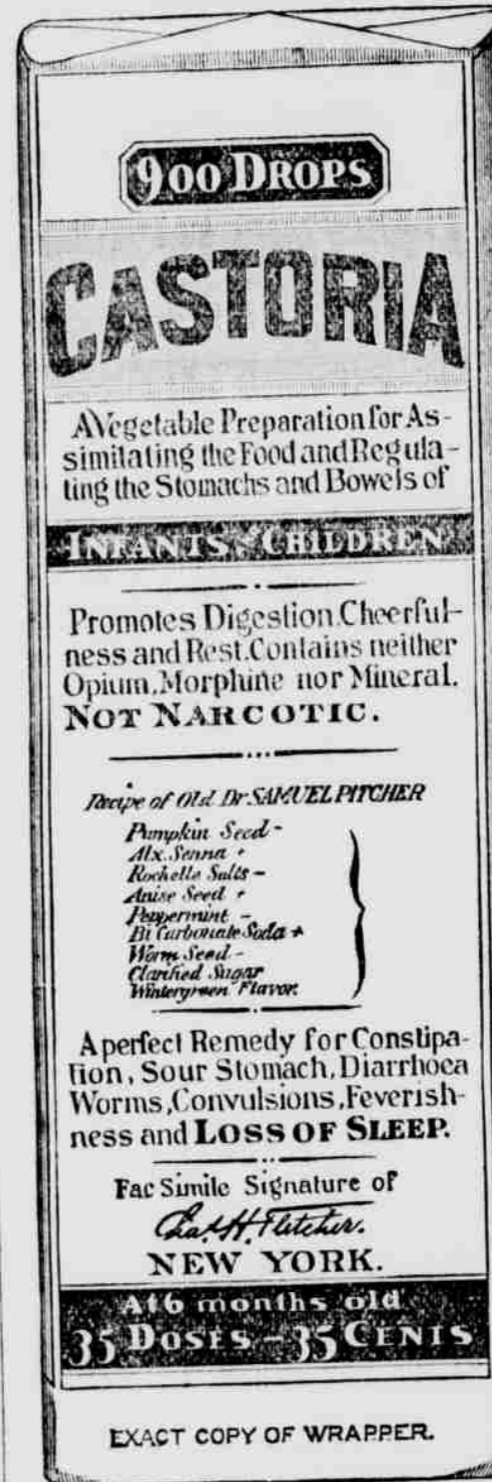

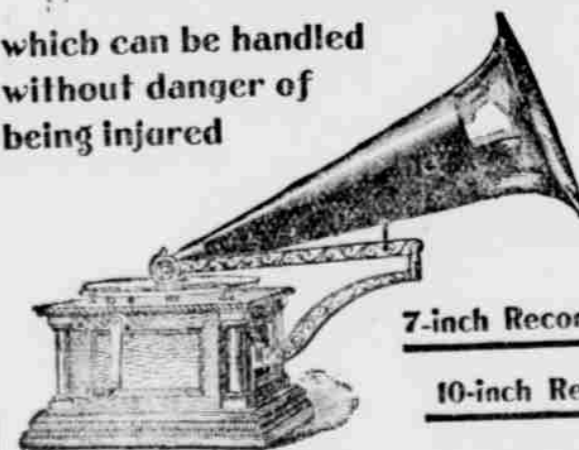
