PLATT SAYS IT IS A LIE

Senator Denies He Is Mixed Up in Postal Scandal.

NOT IN BONDING COMPANY

Spoke--Payne Asks High Officials to Explain the Charges Made Against Them.

New York, May 18 .- Senator Thomas C. Platt today denied the statement made by Seymour W. Tulloch, ex-cashier of the Washington Postoffice, that ex-Superintendent Beavers, of the Salary and Allowance Division of the Postoffice Department, had requested a high official to use his influence to get bonding business for a bonding company which Senator Platt's son is interested in, saying that "Senator Platt would greatly appreciate it."

"The statement is an absolute lie and Tulloch knew it was a lie," said Senator Platt. "I have no interest direct or indirect, in any bonding company."

Assessor Strain's assessment of the O. R. & N. in Umatilla county has been practically completed and shows a raise from about \$4600 per mile to \$13,000 per mile.
