Tapioea Cream Soup.

One quart white stock, one pint cream or milk, one onion, two stalks celery, one-third cup tapioea, two cups cold water, one tablespoon butter, small piece of mace, salt, pepper. Wash the tapioea and soak. Cook it and the stock together, very gently, for one hour. Cut the onion and celery into small pieces, and put on to cook for 20 minutes with the milk and mace. Strain on the tapioea and stock. Season with butter and serve.—Good Housekeeping.

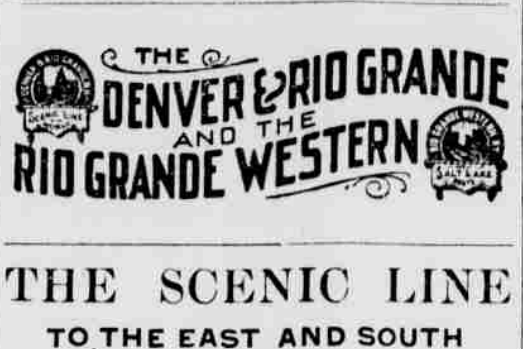
