Portage Rallway Estimates.
Salem, Or., Nov. 6.-The State Board of Portage Railway Commissioners held brief meeting today and andted number of bills incurred in making the
preliminary survey for the right of way peliminary survey for the right of way.
The report of the engineer, previously made orally, was submitted in writing and placed on file. This report con-
tains among other things the estimates nade by the engineer for the informa(ion of the board concerning the probable cost of each class of work and ma terials necessary for the construction and equipment of the road.

nishing the material and work and the publication of the estimates might interfere with their securing the lowe

The Value of Radium
In regard to the value of radium, radium chloride of the activity of 240 sells for about $\$ 30$ an ounce. The ra-
dium salts used by the author in the experiments at the American Museum of Natural History. 127 milligrams-
equal to about one-eighth of a gram or 1249 of an ounce-represented a value of $\$ 274$, or a rate of $\$ 64,800$ per ounce of 300,000 . The museum ordered. at the request of Edward D. Adams, of New York City, and as a gitt to carry tivity of $1,800,000$, valued at $\$ 660$ for 100 tivity of $1,800,000$, valued at miligrams, or at ane
per ounce. The small sample used rep re-ents the concentration of more than one ton of pitchblende; the $1,800,000$ sample, probably the concentration of
four or five tons, and yet the entire quantity could be put in the end of a thimble and not occupy one fourth of the space remaining between that and the finger. Radium compounds with an activity of 40 can be bought for $\$ 20$ an ounce. It is only when it has been fractionated and increased in its activity
that it becomes very costly-like steel, itself worth only a trifle per pound, but when manufactured into watch springs.
