Frost Kept Body.

Seattle, March 4.—The complete form
of a mastodon was discovered at Hillside
on "Quartz Creek" today, according to
a dispatch received by the Post-Intelli-
gencer from Dawson, Y. T. It was im-
bedded 38 feet in the earth when found,
and it necessitated the use of a steam
thawing plant to unearth the immense
animal.

The hair and skin of the beast are in
a perfect state of preservation, although
the flesh is somewhat decomposed, and
the big tusks, which remain fastened to
the skull, are in good condition. It is
estimated that the skeleton is worth
about \$50,000, as there are but one or
two of them in existence in as good a
condition as is this.

Three men, Pierson, Swanson and Port-
er, discovered the mastodon. It was
buried in an old channel and well in the
zone of frost, which accounts for the
good shape it is in.
