RUSSIAN FUNDS FAR FROM LOW.

She Can Carry on the War Some
Time Without Loan.

Washington, Oct. 7.—Russian finan-
cial conditions, with particular refer-
ence to the ability of the Russian
treasury to meet the enormous war ex-
penses, were discussed tonight by
Gregory Vilenkin, financial agent of
the Russian Embassy, in an interview
with the Associated Press. He ex-
plained that the Russian bank notes,
upon the recent large issue of which the
foreign press had laid great stress, are
secured by gold in the treasury. M.
Vilenkin said:

"On February 1 of the current year,
the gold reserve of the state bank con-
sisted of 915,000,000 roubles, while
there were only 598,600,000 roubles of
bank notes in circulation. On August
1, 1904, the gold reserve of the state
bank consisted of 948,700,000 roubles,
while there were only 695,300,000
roubles in bank notes in circulation.

"As a whole, the war expenditure of
Russia from the beginning of the cam-
paign until the end of the year may be
approximately placed at from 625,000,000
to 650,000,000 roubles. With regard to
the means for the covering of this ex-
penditure unforeseen by the budget, it
must be regarded that the reserve in
the government treasury by January 1,
1904, consisted of 312,000,000 roubles,
and after the covering of all of the
standing expenditures according to the
budget of 1904, it amounted to 130,000,-
000 roubles, to which there must be
added 135,000,000 roubles of economies
realized by curtailing of already sanc-
tioned expenditures for the current
year; also 282,000,000 roubles realized
from the issue of five per cent treasury
bonds, and 150,000,000 roubles from the
3 1/2 per cent treasury bills. The govern-
ment treasury thus has at its disposal
approximately 700,000,000 roubles,
which is sufficient for the covering of
the above expenditure without applying
to any new loans."

BEEF RUSTLERS.

Kill Fat Cattle in Mountains and
Market Quarters.

Grants Pass, Oct. 8.—Bold cattle rust-
lers are making much trouble for the
cattlemen in the mountain ranges of
Josephine county. Unlike the rustlers
that operate in the open prairie range,
these thieves have a different method
of procedure, as they kill the heaves in the
woods and bring the meat by wagon to
Southern Oregon market places, either
disposing of it to the butchers or selling
it in small lots to private families.

One leading Josephine county cattle-
man stated today that he has lost, all
told, about twenty three head of cattle,
most of them beef steers in prime con-
dition. Some of his neighbors have
suffered also, and to prevent further
losses they have placed a number of
men, well armed, on the range. These
men will make "dry" camps, build no
fires and follow no beaten path. Thus
their location will never be known.
They will get their supplies as needed
from the ranchers for whom they are
working. They will stalk the woods
and lie in wait day and night, in an un-
tiring attempt to catch the thieves.
They do not want to make trouble, and
will try to avoid it, but if the rustlers
try to escape or show fight, there will
gun plays, as the cattlemen are de-
termined to bring the lawbreakers to
justice.

"The sheriff could do nothing out
there alone," said a stockman today.
"Neither could anything be done even
though he had deputies with him, as
the rustlers keep close watch and would
be out of the way as soon as the sheriff
came into the region. I think we have
adopted the better plan."

For over two years this method of
stealing cattle has been in vogue in
Southern Oregon. The old plan of go-
ing onto the range and driving the ani-
mals out is impossible now, as this can-
not be done without following the main
traveled roads, and as every "critter" is

branded it is un-safe to attempt their
sale, even though they were driven into
an adjoining state. The extensive
range, deep woods and many mountain
trails give excellent opportunity for the
thieves to enter by pack animal, kill one
or more heaves, sack up the meat and
silently withdraw, finally loading it on
wagons when the valley roads are
reached.
