HEPPNERITES ARE MINING.

Are Doing Good Work on Claims
on Crest of Blue Mountains.

Almost on the very crest of the Green-
horn mountains, where several moun-
tain streams form the headwaters of
Boulder creek, a syndicate of Heppner
citizens have quietly developed a group
of claims, until today only the installa-
tion of a mill is needed to repay them
for their confidence in the mineral
wealth of Grant county.

As a rule, but few of the residents of
the state, with the exception of those
residing in the mining districts, are in-
terested in mining enterprises, and
most of the rich properties are controll-
ed by outside capital; therefore the suc-
cess of this syndicate from a section de-
voted almost exclusively to agriculture
and sheep raising is a noteworthy
feature.

The group, which comprises fifteen
claims, is owned and operated by the
Heppner Mining company and has over
1000 feet of tunnels, shafts and surface
workings. D. B. Stalter is president
and general manager of the company.—
Blue Mountain Eagle.

Good News From Holden.

Al Bryant is down from the Holden,
of which he was recently in charge. He
said:

"The mine is looking well. There
has been 110 feet of extension of tunnel
No. 3 this season, making it now over
700 feet in length. It has crosscut into
the ledge between 35 and 40 feet, all in
good ore, with no signs of getting
through.

"In tunnel No. 1 there has been 70
feet of new tunnel, of which 28 feet is in
clean, solid ore, and work stopped in
ore.

"Tunnel No. 2 crosscuts into the
ledge 149 feet, all in ore, with no hang-
ing wall in sight.

"Alongside of the copper ore there is
a vein of galena from three to six feet
wide.

"Ores from tunnel No. 2 run from
\$40 to \$78 for the best ore, and from
tunnel No. 1 from \$150 to \$178, and an
average of the whole mine, from one
end to the other, gives values of \$19 to
\$20 per ton."

J. F. Lansing, of Republic, spent
several days up at the Holden mine last
week.—Spokesman-Review. Henry
Blackman and Geo. Conser are heavy
stockholders in the above company.
There are other residents of Morrow
county having small holdings.
