

WILLIAMSON, GESNER, BIGGS, ARE FOUND GUILTY

The End of a Long and Tedious Case in the Federal Courts.

News by telephone was received in Heppner at 1:30 this afternoon that Congressman J. N. Williamson, Van Gesner and Marion R. Biggs were all found guilty in the land fraud trials which have just been concluded in the federal court in Portland.

The case went to the jury Wednesday afternoon and a verdict of guilty was reached yesterday evening at 11 o'clock.

This is the third trial, the two former trials resulting in a disagreement of the jury each time.

No Sympathy For Wife Beater.

Sumpter, Or., Sept. 21.—The recent lashing of R. W. Cecil, the wife-beating postmaster of Tipton, under an act of the last Oregon legislature, has brought out many opponents to the law in this section. Wife-beating is practically unknown here, and very few of the male residents ever expect to come into contact with the law, but just the same it is thought to be a barbarous proceeding.

Mrs. Cecil, on the other hand, has little sympathy for her brutal husband, and claims she is still disabled from the vicious kick he gave her when she refused to advance him more coin with which to gamble. She states that she cannot even lift the mail sacks that become her duty since her husband's incarceration owing to the injuries she received. It is quite probable that a successor to Cecil will be appointed to act as postmaster, as his present bondmen are opposed to his holding the place any longer.

Feeding In Mathew.

"A deal was signed and the contracts signed at the Bank of Ontario Monday which mean that about 2000 head of range cattle will be fed in this vicinity this winter and 7000 tons of surplus hay will thereby be consumed.

"D. Magill, a John Day stockman, disposed of 1500 head of 3-year-old steers to farmers who will feed them instead of placing their hay on the market. The deal represents about \$65,000 capital. The cattle will come from Bear Valley, in Grant county, Oregon, and will be delivered here about October 15. Mr. Magill will also feed 300 head of his own cattle here and has already purchased sufficient hay for that purpose. Another John Day stockman is figuring on wintering 100 head here.

"Contracts were signed for 1625 head. About 80,000 tons of hay is raised in this valley annually and the farmers have been receiving good prices for their crop until last year, when the stockmen decided that they were asking too much and as a result a large amount of last year's crop was left over."—O. tario Argus.

Sheep To Be Dipped Again.

Weiser, Idaho, Sept. 20.—The Idaho State Sanitary Board met here yesterday and concluded its labors yesterday

evening. Sheepmen were informed by Government agents of the Bureau of Animal Industry who were present that unless they dipped their sheep again this fall, the quarantine on Idaho sheep would not be raised by the Federal authorities, but if they did, it would be removed and sheep allowed to pass out of the state, as it was thought that another dipping would remove the scab from the infected sheep.

Many sheepmen from all over the state were present, and it was decided to comply with the request. The date for dipping is any time between October 1 and November 1.

New Pacing Star.

Readville, Mass., Sept. 22.—More than 3000 enthusiastic followers of harness-racing saw Audubon Boy pace one of the most wonderful miles ever made under adverse conditions at the Readville track today. The time 1.59 1/4, equals the record made by Star Pointer seven years ago. Audubon Boy started to beat 2.00 1/4. Weather favored record time, but the protracted rain earlier in the week left the track heavy.
