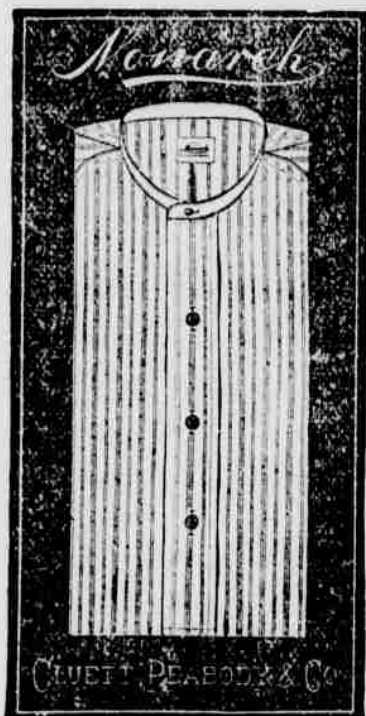

WATER WORKS FOR HARDMAN

Citizens Voted to Bond the City to
Put in System.

A special election was held at
Hardman last Saturday on the
question of bonding the city for
the purpose of putting in a system
of water works to be owned by the
city.

The result of the vote was 16 to
10 in favor of bonding the city for
\$3500 to put in a water system for
fire protection and domestic use,
to be owned and operated by the
city.

The plan contemplated is to dig
a well and put in a gasoline pump-
ing outfit, the water to be pumped
to a reservoir with sufficient eleva-
tion for good pressure.

It is said that the town can get
an ample supply of good water in
this way.
