For the past two weeks, says the Dayton Optimist, we have been anticipating a diet of big, juicy strawberries, but as yet they have not materialized.

Lakeview Herald: A few years from now some of us will be saving, "Only a short time ago this piece of ground and that piece of ground, where those large buildings are, and that fine farm is, were covered with sagebrush, and I could have bought it at \$10 per acre." It will be the same old story, it is part of the history of every country.

There has not been a better strawberry season for many years. The berries are of good size and of extra fine flavor. The frost did absolutely no damage to the fruit this year, and the yield will be extra large, considering the acreage, says the Hood River News-Letter. Indians from the several reservations have arrived in large numbers to harvest the crop, and it is believed that there will be plenty of pickers and packers.

A wooden pipe factory has been established in the Barrett district in the Hood River valley. The plant is capable of running two sets of boring machines simultaneously and of turning out the following amounts daily when run to its full capacity: 2,400 feet of 12 inch; 3,000 feet of 10 inch, 3,400 feet of 7 inch; 3,600 feet of 6 inch and 4 inch pipe. The cores of the larger pipes are bored again; wound and used for high pressure purposes. It is the plan to leave a three inch shell to the pipe. However, much of the pipe bored has a 4 to 6 inch rim.
