### Order Refused.

Notwithstanding the fact that the attorneys for Antone Nolte, plaintiff in the suit brought against the county judge to restrain him from issuing the prohibition proclamation tomorrow, made a special flying trip to Heppner yesterday armed with the complaint and petition and injunction for the restraining order Judge Bean refused to issue the temporary order as prayed for by the plaintiff and there will be nothing to prevent Judge Gilliland of the county court from issuing the proclamation today putting into effect the prohibition in Umatilla county as voted at the recent election.

The complaint in this suit was filed yesterday morning by Richard & Raley and Lowell & Winters, and immediately after the filing Messrs. Richards and Winter chartered an automobile and hit the hill road for Heppner to present the matter to Judge Bean who is holding court in that county this week and if possible to get an injunction from the court restraining Judge Gilliland from issuing the proclamation which is required by the local option law and which is due today.

The Pendleton attorneys did not get to present their case to Judge Bean until about 5 o'clock yesterday afternoon and after they had set the merits of their contentions on behalf of the saloon interests before the court and asked for the restraining order the court refused to grant it, but promised the attorneys that he would give them a hearing on the merits before the first of July, when the saloons must close.—Pendleton Tribune.
