An idea of the immense cost of the navy can be realized when it is made public that the average expense of keeping in repair and seaworthy, each battleship amounts to \$109,856.09.

At no time during the history of Oregon was the state being so thoroughly advertised as at present. Business men of Portland are sending out leaflets which emphasize the statement, "You can buy your ticket to any point in Oregon just as cheaply as to Portland."

A statement just issued shows that 557 miles of railway were constructed in Mexico during 1908. This is a large amount of building when compared with the work done in the United States, where 3500 miles were built last year, against 5500 in 1907. The official figures show that there were 11,760 miles of railroad in operation in Mexico, January 1, about two thirds of this being standard gauge and the remainder narrow gauge. It is also estimated that less than 500 miles of new road will be built in the country during 1909.

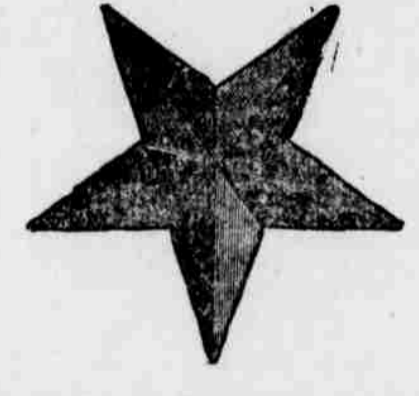
