They show much aptitude in recognizing new words, their work in phonics having prepared them for this kind of work. One class also did some very creditable work in numbers. The other class did not recite in numbers while I was present. I noted that most of the pupils were careful and painstaking with their slate work.

On Friday, I visited the Lexington school a short time. I found Prof. Wilcox and his assistants busy with the closing work of the year. The teachers and pupils feel that they have done a good year's work.
 In the evening a local educational meeting was held at the hall. A large crowd was in attendance, including several teachers from the adjoining districts. On the program were several excellent musical numbers and recitations. Misses Ruth Brown and Vesta Cutsforth and Prof. Wilcox each read an interesting and instructive paper. The writer spoke a short time upon "The Influence of Environment."

The pupils of the Lexington school and some of their friends have made arrangements for water with which to irrigate the school grounds. W. G. Scott furnishes the wind-mill and the water. The pipe has been laid into the school yard and the trees are not lacking in irrigation now. Several trees are already planted and more will be planted next year.
