El Paso, Tex.-The Vasquista rebel element has taken possession of Ciudad Juarez. The capture of the city was accomplished after the firing of a single volley, with only a few scattering shots of resistance. The rebeis entered the outskirts of the city from the northwest and fired as they entered, using rifles and one cannon. The few hundred men in Juarez, as defenders, fired a few shots from various points of vantage, and were then ordered by their officers to


