NEW DEPARTURE IN MERCANTILE BUSINESS

E. L. Rayburn & Sons is the name under which a business begun six years ago by the senior Rayburn, is now conducted. Mr. Rayburn has been successful from the start but experience has shown him there is room in Lents for at least one general cash store. The losses incident to the credit system, and the necessary addition to prices to cover those losses, convinced the Rayburns that the economical plan for them, at least, was to try a strictly cash business. Within the past month they have adopted that system and their experiences seem to favor continuance of the plan. There was some complaint at first and a few customers demurred, yet on the other hand there has been some gain, trade continuing good.

They plan to buy goods in large orders. As high as 80 sacks of beans, 300 sacks of flour, 300 of meal, and canned goods and other staples in like proportion. They have exclusive sale for several lines of goods for this section of the country, and of them they especially have a heavy trade. Buying in such quantity they get bottom prices, which in turn enables them to give their patrons the benefit of the advantage.

\$1.100 FOR TOMATOES RAISED ON THREE-QUARTERS OF AN ACRE

Eastern Oregon can be counted on to do its share in the state's agricultural production. Now that the crops are gathered, instances of big yields are being reported. Elba Rogers, a farmer of the Freewater district, received over \$1,100 for tomatoes raised on three-quarters of an acre. His crop was marketed through the Fruit Growers' Union, which was probably responsible for a good price. Curtis and Rolph, of Ontario, dug 1,600 bushels of splendid potatoes from two and one-half acres. From one hill, 66 potatoes were taken. More than seven carloads of pure alfalfa honey was shipped, cut of Valo this year.
