Disasters at Sea.

The recent appalling calamity at sea, the loss of the steamship Atlantic of Cape Prospect, Nova Scotia, and the drowning of between five and six hundred persons—passengers, sailors, and crew,—has sent a shock throughout the civilized globe as well as the electric flash could carry the dreadful word so harrowing to the eye and ear of the world, and so awful for all who contemplate it.

went down with over 300 on board.
January 20, 1854.—The emigrant ship "The Atlas," with 381 souls on board, went to pieces on the Irish coast.

May, 1854.—The British troop ship Lady Nugent, from Madras, on her way to England, foundered in a hurricane when only a few days out.

The loss of life was over 400.
November, 1854.—The steamship City of Glasgow was lost—just when or where has never been revealed—and 480 lives were lost.

September 12, 1857.—The steamship Central America, from Aspinwall with passengers from California for New York, foundered at the edge of the Gulf Stream, and out of 476 on board only 152 were saved, leaving a loss of 322 lives.

September 13, 1858.—The steamship Austria, bound to New York, with 538 souls on board, was buried in mid-ocean by culpable carelessness of the commander and officers, and all but 67 perished—a total loss of 471 lives.

October 26, 1859.—The steamship Royal Charter was wrecked off Anglesea, and 441 lives perished.

April 27, 1863.—The Steamship Anglo Saxon was lost on the Banks of Newfoundland, and of 447 on board, only 152 were saved, leaving a loss of 295 lives.

The record from which we extract these, with the wreck last given above. The list of disasters is continued for two or three years later, but in it are no cases where the loss of life was so high as 200 by any one wreck, and we have omitted from the catalogue any disaster in which the loss fell much below 250. It is only the extraordinary losses we have essayed to present. But besides the disasters mentioned we can call to mind several that do not appear in the record, for instance: The burning of the steamer Lexington on Long Island Sound; the loss of the steamer Atlantic in the same waters; the foundering at sea, a few days out of New York, bound for Aspinwall, with soldiers and passengers, of the new steamship San Francisco; and the burning at sea, only a few years back, of a Bremen steamship crowded with passengers; in each case the loss of life having been very large.

Contrasted with other coasts and all things considered the loss of life has been very much smaller on this coast during the last twenty years than anywhere else on the globe, and this remark is singularly applicable to the coast and coasting vessels of Oregon. And there is hardly a bar in the world where fewer disasters occur than at the Bar entrance of the Columbia River.—Bulletin.
