Radical State Platform.

The Republican party of the State of Oregon, in Convention assembled, declared that the end of Government is to secure equal and exact justice to all its citizens...

Resolved, That the government of the people, by the people and for the people, is the only form of government...

Resolved, That party organizations are useful and necessary, and that while we are proud of the birth and history of the Republican party...

Resolved, That while we recognize the full right of every citizen to express and act upon his convictions, upon all questions of public interest...

Resolved, That we sympathize with every movement to secure for agriculture and labor their due influence, interests and rights...

Resolved, That the interests of this State demand its commercial relations with other States of the Union, both present and prospective...

Resolved, That we are in favor of Congressional aid for the construction of a wagon road from some point in Rogue River Valley to the nearest practicable point on the coast...

Resolved, That we are opposed to the purchase or leasing by this State of the canal and locks at the Falls of the Willamette River...

Resolved, That we are in favor of such legislation to regulate the sale of intoxicating liquors as will restrain the abuses growing out of its indiscriminate license and operate as a salutary and needful check upon the growing evils of intemperance...

Democratic Platform.

The following platform of principles was adopted by the Democratic State Convention at Albany last Wednesday:

1. We declare our unflinching devotion to the maintenance of the Union of the States and to the Union of the States as established, and we affirm that the people of the United States have the sole and exclusive right of governing themselves as free, sovereign and independent States...

2. We affirm that the greatest danger with which we are now threatened, is the corruption and extravagance which exists in high official places...

3. The present Federal Administration, by its utter inability to comprehend the dignity or responsibilities of the office which it is engaged, by its devotion to personal and party interests, by its weak and inconsistent administration of the national finances, by its unvaried interference with the local self-government of the people...

4. That we disapprove all measures in the interests of capitalists and monopolists, and in favor of the laboring class...

5. That we are in favor of Congressional aid for the construction of a wagon road from some point in Rogue River Valley to the nearest practicable point on the coast...

6. That we are in favor of the construction of a canal and locks at the Falls of the Willamette River...

7. That we are in favor of such legislation to regulate the sale of intoxicating liquors as will restrain the abuses growing out of its indiscriminate license...
